### An Interview with Mary Kelly, MD

#### *Where are you from originally?*

I grew up in New Jersey and went to school in Washington, D.C. and Connecticut. I was a history major but while writing for several hospital public relations departments in D.C., I became intrigued with medicine. I encountered many women who were exploring career opportunities, including the medical profession, newly open to them thanks to the Women's Movement.

In the midst of my pre-med courses, my husband Tom and I decided to try living on the West Coast for a couple of years before settling on the East Coast. We had exactly one friend here who thought we'd enjoy it, so we packed a van full of our stuff and headed west. Little did we know Seattle would become our permanent home.

#### *How did you become a radiologist and what attracted you to the profession?*

I was fortunate to be accepted into the University of Washington School of Medicine in 1976. I did my internship at Virginia Mason and my residency at UW Medicine. I found radiology totally fascinating during my med school clerkships and Dr. Rohrmann recruited me to his diagnostic radiology program. Back then, about 16% of UW medical students were female. In the radiology residency, there was about one woman per year.

During my education and training, I never felt at a disadvantage because of my gender. When it came time for me to take the radiology oral exam for board certification, I happened to be seven months pregnant. It may have startled a few of the examiners but they did not blink an eyelash and I passed the boards.

#### *What was your experience like working with Dr. Rohrmann?*

Dr. Rohrmann was an excellent role model. He was demanding and inspiring at the same time. My very first rotation in the residency was on his gastrointestinal service at Harborview. I still recall some of the striking images we captured of rampant pathology at that hospital.

I remember after I was elected to be chief resident, I was at a social event with Chuck and other radiologists. A former resident jokingly said to Chuck, "So you didn't elect one of the boys?" Without missing a beat, Chuck replied, "Mary is one of the boys." I thought that was pretty funny and took it as a compliment. It was emblematic of his evenhanded support of all residents, as well as his droll sense of humor.

I think the high caliber of the UW residents can be in no small part attributed to Chuck. He has set a tone of integrity

and of intellectual curiosity. He is a kind, funny, and highly effective leader who leads by example. The program is very fortunate that he's chosen to participate for as long as he has.

#### *What type of radiology were you most interested in and where have you worked?*

I especially enjoyed ultrasound, receiving great training from Drs. Laurence Mack and Jack Hirsch in the residency in that subspecialty. I evolved into a breast imaging specialist. I worked at Group Health for the first 10 years of my career, coincident with the development of GHC's innovative breast cancer screening program. I served as GHC central head of radiology. I was then recruited by my former fellow, Dr. James Rogers, to Providence Hospital to help lead its breast center. I was at Providence/Swedish for 20 years, specifically working on implementing best practices in breast cancer diagnosis and intervention at multiple locations of the Swedish breast centers. Over the course of that time, I served as a board member and as the chief medical officer for my radiology group, Radia, Inc., P.S.


#### *What advice do you give to radiology residents today?*

Radiology residents today are so brilliant and well-prepared, it is hard to think of anything they need advice on! One thing I would say, which I learned from the joy of taking care of breast patients, is that the residents should consider themselves "clinicians." All radiologists are. They should embrace the opportunity to meet with and talk with patients. Regardless of their subspecialty, it will make them better at what they do and it is part of the joy of the practice of medicine.

## 2018 AUR Radiology Resident Academic Leadership Development (ARRALD) Program - Supported by the Rohrmann Endowment

I had the pleasure of attending the AUR 66th annual meeting in Orlando, Florida to participate in the AUR Radiology Resident Academic Leadership Development (ARRALD) Program. This year's keynote conference topics focused on "Health and Well-Being of the Profession and the Professional." Notable presentations included the Plenary Session on "Insights into Depression during Medical Training and the Biology of Stress and Resilience" by Srijan Sen, MD, PhD (Ann Arbor, MI) and the Keynote Lecture on "Cultivating Mindfulness and Resilience for Ourselves and Our Trainees" by Frederick J. Marshall, MD (Rochester, NY).

As radiologists, we uphold incredible responsibilities: being stewards of medical imaging, offering diagnostic consultation from referring colleagues of myriad specialties, and communicating effectively to the patients we help. We are expected to maintain a vocational professionalism in a dynamic healthcare platform that continuously expects more value and higher quality, a stressful deed. Nevertheless, we should realize that radiologists are humans with the same emotional, physical, and mental boundaries as any other well-intentioned individual. Our psyche may fatigue, leading to a decline in professional satisfaction and corroding our vitality. Sometimes burn-out leads to depression. Therefore, we have an obligation to cultivate an environment enriched

with communal awareness, wellness, and support. This year's AUR talks heavily refined how I approach my daily routine. By leveraging tools such as mindfulness and meditation, I hope to galvanize my psyche for the future rigors of training and beyond. My interprofessional relationships with co-residents catalyze that effect. I encourage all of us to institute a small change into our daily routine in efforts to either improve or maintain our drive to the profession we love. Examples I learned include changing network passwords to "words of positivity" or taking five minutes each morning to reflect on yesterday's accomplishments.

The ARRALD program provides 30-40 second year radiology residents with a small group activity focused curriculum which highlights leadership, communication, and project development. We participated in various sessions including networking, balancing life and an academic radiology career, different perspectives on leadership, conflict resolution, and process improvement. Most sessions were moderated by radiology department chairs across the country including Carolyn Meltzer, MD (Emory); Alexander Norbash, MD (UCSD); and Hedvig Hricak, MD, PhD (Memorial Sloan Kettering). I had the opportunity to brainstorm ideas with vibrant and inspiring resident minds from across the country. ARRALD

is an incredible investment for the future leaders of radiology and I look forward to reciprocating my training both as a radiologist and as a steward to the future of radiology.

I greatly appreciate the UW residency program for supporting and nominating me to participate in ARRALD. In addition, I thank the generous donors of the UW Medicine Rohrmann Endowment for UW Radiology Resident Educational Excellence. Both were instrumental to my attendance at AUR 2018.





*What are some of your favorite activities outside of work?*
